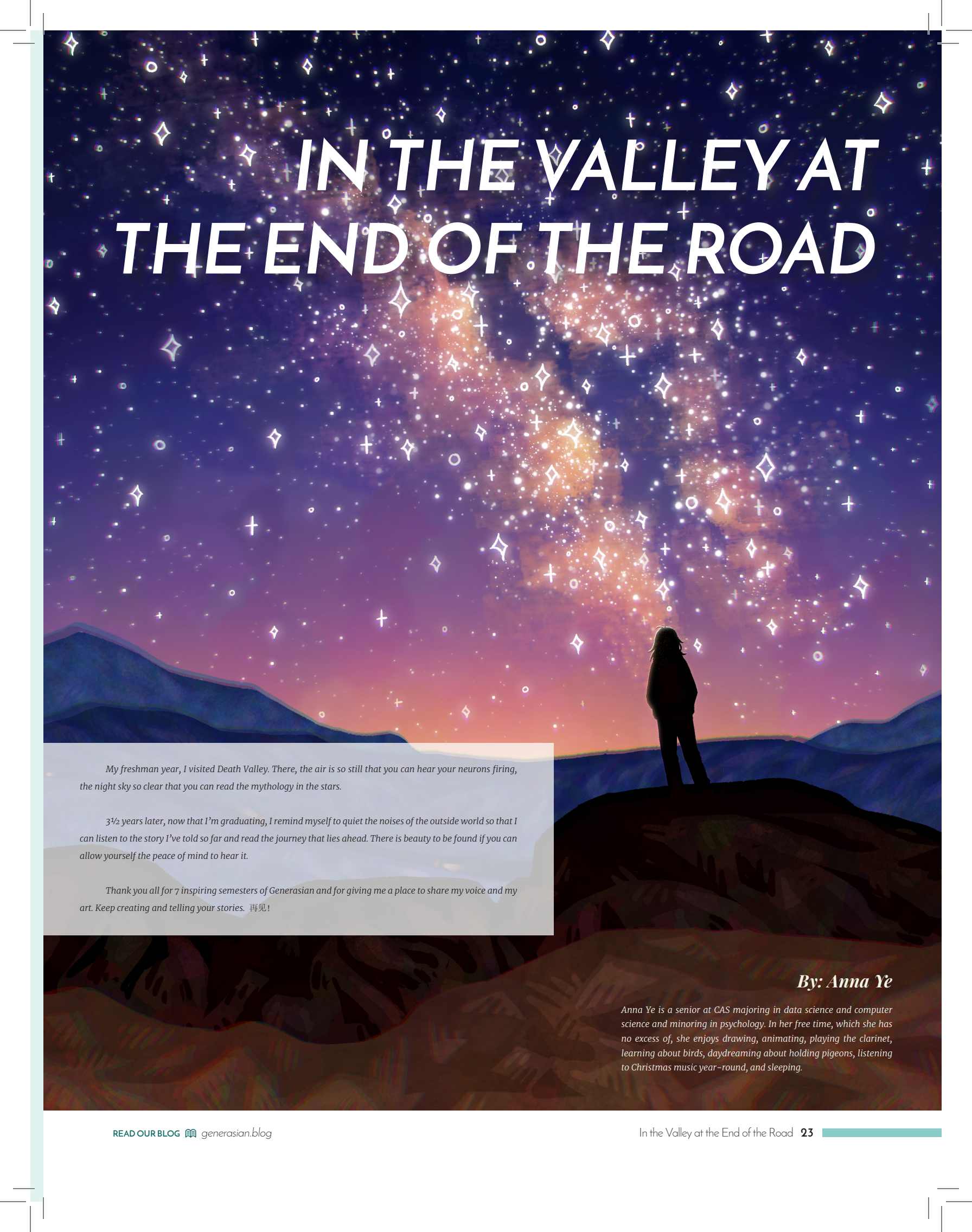




IN THE VALLEY AT THE END OF THE ROAD
